Accelerated Freefall (AFF) course information

Accelerated Freefall or AFF is the ultimate way to learn how to skydive. The course consists of 8 levels in which you learn how to fly your body through the air at speeds of 120 MPH from a height of 12500ft. On completion of the course you are then able to skydive on your own and soon after you will obtain your British Parachute Association 'A' licence.

What does the course consist of?

The course is designed to 'accelerate' you from never having jumped before to being able to skydive with competence on your own.

The course starts with a minimum of 6 hours ground school followed by 7 skydives from an altitude of 12500 ft and 1 from 5000ft.

Levels 1 – 3 are with 2 instructors, in which you will learn how to maintain a stable position, stay pointing in the same direction, monitor your altitude and finally but not least deploy your main parachute.

Levels 4 – 7 are with 1 instructor, in which you will learn how to start and stop turns, do 360 degree turns, dive head first out of the aircraft, perform a back loop and how to move forward.

Level 8 is on your own. You leave the aircraft at a minimum of 5000ft and deploy your main parachute whilst in a stable position within 10 seconds.

Our instructors

Our instructors are fully qualified, dedicated and hand picked by HEAT sports. We offer you some of the best BPA instructors in the UK so that your skydiving experience is 1 to remember and enjoy.

Your safety

Skydiving is very safety orientated for obvious reasons. We use state of the art equipment; you will have 2 parachutes, a main parachute and a reserve canopy. The Equipment is also fitted with safety back up devices. All HEAT Sports skydiving is run in accordance with the British Parachute Association (BPA), who is the governing body for skydiving in the UK.

Can any 1 do an AFF course?

There are some restrictions:

You must be over 16 years old (under 18's must have a parental consent form signed)

If you are over 40 you must have a medical signed and stamped by your doctor. If you are over 50 please contact us for more information.

There is a weight limit of 15 stone 8 pounds.

Price

The price* for the AFF course is as follows:

AFF course California £1550* (courses run Sept - may, please call for the details of the next course)

This includes levels 1-8 plus 10 consolidation jumps, all the kit, log book and goggles. This course is normally run over 10-12 days.

AFF course Spain £1150*

This includes levels 1-8, all the kit, log book, goggles. Insurance available at the drop zone. This course is normally run over 7-10 days

AFF course UK £1300*

This includes levels 1-8, all the kit, log book, goggles and BPA insurance. This course is run at weekends only and only limited by the weather.
